

Minutes of Special Meeting  
April 29, 2005

Meeting to discuss problems on Goad Drive and  
Rezoning of Property south of City limits.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Hyland at 6 P. M.

Council present: Mayor Hyland, Council persons Gerald Tschida, Duane Ziebarth, Duane Brownie and Terry Trude.

Public present: Chris Erickson, Ted Erickson, Randy Saari, Mrs. Saari, Charles Beck, Jeff Baker, Lee Williams, Betty Williams, Kevin House.

Letters concerning both issues were also received and became part of the meeting.

The problems of appliances and furniture and unlicensed vehicles as well as other trash visible as you drive by 319 Goad Drive. This has been a problem for several years and is a real eye sore for the City.

Resolution offered by Hyland seconded by Ziebarth to have the City attorney pursue this through the courts and get it taken care of.

Roll call vote all council members voted yes.

Second issue deals with rezoning part of the N \_ of NE \_ of SR \_ of section 29, township 48N, range 16W, Town of Silver Brook.

After much discussion of some of the problems that could develop concerning the City of Wrenshall and its citizens the following resolution was adopted:

Resolution offered by Hyland seconded by Trude:

Where as: This is located over part of the Aquifer our City well is on, and

Where as: one quart of petroleum product can contaminate 200,000 gallons of water, and

Where as: a spill of any size could contaminate our City water system completely, and

Where as: the volume of trucks carrying petroleum through town would be greatly increased, causing the possibility of increased accidents, and

Where as: the residential growth of the City is moving to the south, if this is rezoned as requested it could slow and possibly stop our residential growth.

Now therefore be it resolved that the City of Wrenshall is strongly opposed to this rezoning. It is in a sandy loam area which makes it more of a problem.

Roll call vote all council members voted yes.
