

Minutes of Public Hearing on Water Tower.  
June 13, 2005

Mayor Hyland introduced all council persons and City Engineer Cris Rousseau.

All present were presented a agenda for the meeting.

Cris explained some of the problems we are having with the old system, which has served the city well to this point. We need to loop some of the dead end lines and provide better water pressure, not only for home use but also for fire protection.

We could add on to the existing system and get by for a short period. The city is growing so we must provide a better system if we want to continue to grow.

We have selected a site for the new tower, it is just west of the City garage where there is a water line which can be used to tie the new tower into the system.

Many questions were asked by those present and they were all answered to the satisfaction of those present.

Methods of financing the project were discussed. No definite answer is available at this time.

We will also be putting in water meters so those that use excess water will be paying for it. These will be put in at the property owners expense. We will work out a payment system to help property owners accomplish the installation.
